To Charge or Not to Charge

To charge or not to charge for classes is the question we, the Unity Leaders in this region, have been grappling with.

As you may know we are getting a website where you will be able to register for classes plus see what's coming up. Won't that be good?

Kelly Isola is tithing her time and talent, as is Julian Harvey, to help us with this. Thank you Kelly and Julian.

Now should you pay for the classes? Just to be clear at the moment we offer all classes on a love offering basis. None of your facilitators gets paid for these. Those of you who want to gain credit for the class are required to pay \$50 as a registration fee. This does not go to the facilitator. It goes into the Unity National School Account and contributes to the Director's annual honorarium and administration costs.

Now what I notice is that there are a few of you who contribute handsomely to Unity National School. What this does is enable us to reward our facilitators well. To give you some idea when we started running all SEE classes over a two year period we were only able to give our facilitators about \$300 for a whole week of teaching. For every hour of class there is about 3-4 hours of preparation.

Two years in we were able to give \$500 to each facilitator. Better but still not great. Now we are able to give around \$1000 for a class going over 5-6 weeks. I'm feeling really good about that although it's still short of compensating them adequately for the work.

What I want to emphasise here is the reason why you should give. Charles Fillmore said, "without giving the soul shrivels". I'm sure none of you want a shrivelled soul! Are you aware of what giving can do for you? I love Charles Fillmore's Prosperity Lesson called "Right Giving the Key to Abundant Receiving". You need to give, where is up to you.

Give where you receive your spiritual food. I know some of you think that because you give to your Unity centre that should cover the classes as well. That's a bit like paying the butcher

We are trialling having everyone register by donation.

If you are taking classes for credit you also need to pay the administration fee of \$50.

If any of this is onerous for you please feel free to reach out to me.

I know when I first started with Unity it felt like I had to be giving money all the time. I didn't understand the idea that giving was an important part of my soul development.

I think I had a very shrivelled soul in those days. It took me a while to up my level of giving.

I now understand what Charles Fillmore meant when he said it's not money that's the problem but the thoughts we have about money.

Notice your thoughts. Thoughts are things. Choose the good ones.

and then telling the greengrocer that you've already paid for the meal.

I think of spiritual food like filling my car with petrol. I don't



hesitate to pay the \$80 or \$90 a week or two to fill her up. Yet when it comes to a love offering for a session am I thinking \$20 does it? Hmm perhaps \$50 or even more each session would be reasonable. Isn't my spiritual food as important or more than filling my car?

It took me a few years to really get this. Charles Fillmore's lesson helped. He wrote: "The law of giving and receiving that Jesus taught, "Give, and it shall be given unto you," is found to be applicable to all our commercial as well as our social relationships."

Study that lesson if you are interested in increasing your prosperity, not just in money terms but in overall well-being. Emerson wrote that you cannot out give God. I've been trying and it's true. You can't. Try it for yourself.

So you can probably tell from this that I don't want to go down the track of charging for our classes. I love the idea that these teachings are available to all regardless of financial situation and that if/when you apply the teachings your life, including your financial well-being, improves.

The "free-will offering" plan is what built Unity. A very different model from "pay for services". It allows you to give as you wish without compulsion. I believe it is the way we all can prosper.

When we, the Unity leaders, discussed this we liked the idea put forward by Anne Hickey. She says she uses "register by donation". So what that means is that in order for you to take a class even "I just want to sit in" type participation you will need to give a donation, a koha, a "free-will love offering".

Let me know if you like that idea too. We will trial it in the upcoming classes.

You will develop a basic understanding of the Christian Scriptures' meaning for the people to whom they were written. This course is based on the premise that, whatever else the Christian Scriptures may be; they most definitely *are* the response of early Christian writers to both the person and the message of Jesus Christ. This course examines the Christian Scriptures as a testament *about* Jesus by early Christian communities.

You will need this book and a Bible (New Revised Standard Version recommended).

Borg's "Evolution of the Word" also recommended.







